The Breakfast Club continues to serve Learning Centre students every morning in the student lunch room! The Breakfast Club menu follows the Canadian Food Guide and provides students with a **full healthy breakfast** or a snack before the school day begins. Each breakfast is served with fruit and either juice or milk. Research has shown that eating breakfast increases concentration and confidence in class. Breakfast is **50 cents** per day. A week of Breakfast is \$2 and a whole month of breakfast is \$8. If you
